Exam checklist

Before the exams:

- ✓ Check the exam plan and fill in the necessary information (e.g. external examiner and appeal examiner)
- ✓ 3 weeks before the exam you will receive a course approval list from your exam coordinator
- ✓ The course approval list must be submitted to your exam coordinator 14 calendar days before the exam

Create and submit question sets in Inspera:

- ✓ Upload question sets in Inspera, home exam and/or school exam
- ✓ All exams must have an updated cover page, use <u>Cover Page Templates</u>
- ✓ Remember Bokmål, Nynorsk and English versions where necessary
- ✓ Send the grading guidelines to ISL-eksamen@hf.ntnu.no or upload directly in Inspera. The grading guidelines must be published in Blackboard after the publication of the grades. A template for the grading guidelines can be found on T:\hf\isl\Alle ansatte\Undervisning\Kvalitetssikring av utdanning\Sensurveiledning
- ✓ The deadline for uploading question sets in Inspera is 10 working days before the exam date.

During the exam:

- ✓ The examination room for the written exam is published three days before the exam on exam info on the course page
- ✓ The lecturer or representative must be available by phone during the exam https://i.ntnu.no/wiki/-/wiki/English/Presence+of+teaching+staff+during+exams

After the exam:

- ✓ Exam answers are made available immediately after the exam ends in Inspera. Note When using SCANTRON/hand drawings, upload delays may occur
- ✓ Grading in Inspera Assessment
- ✓ Check exam answers for <u>plagiarism</u>
- ✓ Do you suspect cheating? Notify your exam coordinator

Grading:

- ✓ The deadline for grading is 3 weeks. The deadline for grading can be found in the exam plan
- ✓ Read about <u>explanation of grades and appeals</u> for students
- ✓ Read about grades and appeals in Inspera for academic staff

Finally, some tips and reminders:

- ✓ Recommended web browsers for using Inspera are Google Chrome and Firefox
- ✓ If there is significant grade discrepancy after the appeal, a third, additional assessment must be made in accordance with the stipulated guidelines. This applies in cases where the grade has changed by two or more grades.
- ✓ Students can request an explanation of the new grade after the appeal.
