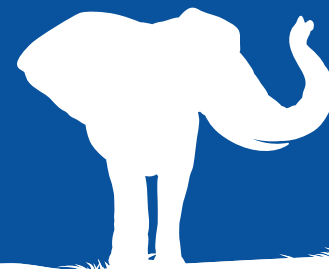
LEARNING SAFARI
