Deadlines

26 February – Deadline for support notification

The Rector has established a central support team to assist in developing ideas and writing applications. The central support team provides help for academic environments that the faculties want to prioritize. The faculties must notify <u>Kirsti Rye Ramberg</u> of any needs as soon as possible, and no later than **Friday 26 February**.

25 April – Deadline for applications to the NTNU Assessment Committee

The faculties assess whether the applications are good enough to be submitted to the NTNU Assessment Committee. The faculties submit their final applications to the Assessment Committee no later than **Monday 25 April** (via ePhorte 2016/3021). The candidates should be allowed to keep working on details in the application.

13 May – Candidates are sent to NOKUT

The NTNU Assessment Committee present their suggestions for NTNU's SFU candidates to the Rector on **Monday 9 May**. The Rector selects NTNU's candidates. NTNU's candidates are submitted to NOKUT by 12:00 noon on Friday 13 May.

SFU candidates who progress to phase 2 will receive a visit by the NOKUT International Expert Committee. The faculties will arrange the visit. The faculties are advised to carry out a dress rehearsal before the visit.
