### Support network

**The following support network is available to help the SFU candidates the faculties want to prioritize:**

[Associate Professor Reidar Lyng, Uniped](#), will contribute in idea development. Reidar has knowledge that makes him particularly suited to help the academic environments at NT, IME and IVT. He is also available for preliminary discussions with academic environments.

[Professor Leif Martin Hokstad, Uniped](#), provides support for the environment surrounding TRANSark (AB). TRANSark was a finalist at the SFU stage in 2013.

[NTNU's Learning Support Centre \(in Norwegian\)](#) offers a "technology/pedagogy talk" for SFU candidates during the initial stage of the application period. The Learning Support Centre can read through applications before they are submitted to the central NTNU committee responsible for recommending candidates to the Rector, but they will not be actively involved in the writing process.

A support team has been established in the Rector's staff to assist with the creation of application budgets. Contact [Senior Executive Officer Øyvind Toldnes](#) to request support.

Applications are submitted in English. The international contact person at PLU, Peter Gray, will provide assistance with application writing and quality assurance. He is also scheduled to give a course to help the SFU candidates create their applications, if there is interest among the candidates.
